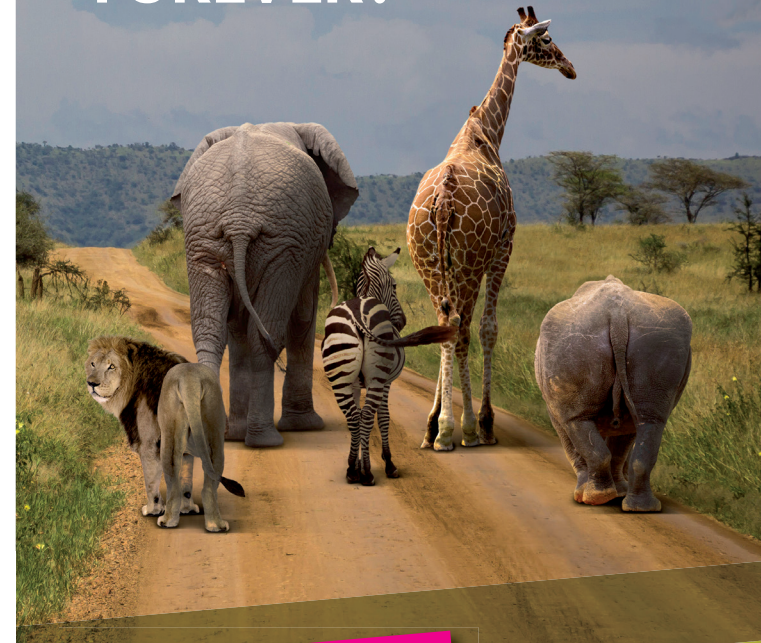

## AWARE project areas in Zimbabwe and national parks



### ■ NATIONAL PARKS

Approximately 11% of Zimbabwe is protected as National Parks.

In the south and west they are connected with National Parks of the neighbouring countries to form large transfrontier wildlife protection areas.

## What does AWARE do?

**ANTI POACHING CAMPAIGNS** Wildlife poaching in Africa has dramatically increased over the past few years. Populations of e.g. rhinos, elephants, or lions have been drastically reduced or even been brought to the edge of extinction.

AWARE improves the equipment of the rangers in the wildlife reserves by providing vehicles, fuel, GPS gear, cameras, tents, rain protection and food rations.

Rhinos are killed by poachers for their horns which are sold in asia as aphrodisiac or “wonder drug” for all kinds of diseases. For this reason rhinos have become one of the most endangered species in Africa. As part of the National rhino protection strategy of Zimbabwe they are regularly “dehorned” by AWARE field teams. By removing their horns we render the animals worthless for poachers. The procedure is painless but has to be repeated every few years when the horns have regrown.

**REHABILITATION** AWARE offers free veterinary services to injured wild animals in National Parks, especially if these injuries have been inflicted by poaching or other human influence.

**PROPHYLAXIS CAMPAIGNS** AWARE carries out free vaccination and castration of dogs in the poor rural regions bordering wildlife areas. This reduces the spread of diseases (e.g. rabies, distemper) and their transmission in and out of the reserves. Both humans and animals benefit from this health improvement.

In collaboration with the British organisation SPANA, AWARE offers free healthcare for donkeys. As these animals are vital means of transportation for the poor rural population, their health care not only improves the well-being of the animals but helps building trust between AWARE and the local communities. This is the basis of any cooperation regarding environment and wildlife conservation.

**EDUCATION** AWARE is involved in educational campaigns for the local population. This aims at increasing the consciousness for the importance of saving wild animals and their natural habitats and teaches respect and empathy for the needs of both domesticated and wild animals. More than 1.000 school children visit the AWARE education center near the capital Harare every month. AWARE engages in the continuing education of veterinarians, eg. in wildlife medicine and conservation management.

**RESEARCH** AWARE initiates and supports various scientific research programs on wildlife animals, their diseases and changes in their natural habitats.
